

This survey was conducted online within the United States from May 17-18, 2023, among **2,004 registered voters** by The Harris Poll and HarrisX.

Results were weighted for age within gender, region, race/ethnicity, marital status, household size, income, employment, education, political party, and political ideology where necessary to align them with their actual proportions in the population. Propensity score weighting was also used to adjust for respondents' propensity to be online.





How strong do you think the U.S. economy is today?




Would you say that your personal financial situation is improving or getting worse?



Do you think the U.S. is in a recession now, will be in a recession in the next year or most likely will avoid a recession?























If the Democratic presidential primary for the 2024 election was held today, who would you vote for? (DEM voters)








Do you think Donald Trump will win or lose the Republican primary for president? (All voters)





Do you think Joe Biden will win or lose the Democratic primary for president? (All voters)























Do you think President Biden is able to serve another full term as president or do you think Kamala Harris would wind up taking over at some point if Biden is re-elected?






Is Joe Biden mentally fit to serve as President of the United States or do you have doubts about his fitness for office? (Split sample)





Is your principal source of news information from...?














Have you heard or not heard anything about the release of Special Counsel John Durham's final report on the circumstances of how the FBI launched the Trump-Russia probe?



















Does the US government need wide-ranging reform to prevent interference in elections by law enforcement and the intelligence community, or have we already made changes post-2016 to avoid any type of interference?





Do you think that the Hunter Biden laptop is real, or is it Russian disinformation?






Do you think that the FBI and Justice Department are fully investigating the Hunter Biden laptop and his foreign business dealings, or do you think they are not really fully investigating these issues?






























How many border crossings by illegal immigrants do you think have been occurring daily since the repeal of Title 42?




How many border crossings by illegal immigrants do you think are occurring each year?






































